PROCEDURE

Please:

- Read the entire FBC Child Safety Program booklet which is accessible under the Child Safety tab.
- Complete the Application for Children/Youth Work, making certain to give complete reference information, sign the application, and have a witness sign and date the application.
- Complete the Criminal Records Check Form if you are age 18 or older.
- If applying as a Teen Helper, complete the Parental Permission Form.
- View the Child Safety DVD accessible under the Child Safety tab.
- Return the completed forms to Associate Pastor, Rick Schrenker, our Child Safety Director or drop them in the Child Safety boxes located at the Welcome Centers.
- Print out or save the Child Safety Policy Booklet located under the Child Safety tab for future reference.

You will be contacted by our Child Safety Director for an interview

After completion of the above process, we will notify you by letter of your approval as a Children's Ministry Worker. You may begin to work after receipt of the Approval Letter from the Pastor. In the event that an issue arises, you may be contacted again for more information or clarification.

PARENTAL PERMISSION FORM FOR CHILDREN'S MINISTRY HELPERS

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Your teenager has expressed interest in serving as a helper in the Children's Ministries at Friendship Baptist Church. The role of a Teen Helper is to assist Adult Workers in ministering to children up to 5th grade (or about age 11). To serve as a Teen Helper, your teenager must be at least fifteen (15) years old and meet and maintain the other qualifications of an Adult Worker except for age. The requirements are:

- 1) Saved, Baptized, and a Member of Friendship Baptist Church in good standing
- 2) At least fifteen (15) years of age
- 3) Burdened for the well-being of children and a desire to minister to them
- 4) Never been convicted of or pled guilty to child sexual or physical abuse, or of a crime involving actual or attempted sexual molestation of a minor
- 5) Completed an "Application for Children/Youth Work" form
- 6) Viewed the Child Safety DVD
- 7) Completed a personal interview with the Pastor or Associate Pastor
- 8) Approved by the Pastor

Parents must give permission for a teenager to serve as a Teen Helper. Thank you in advance for allowing your teenager to minister to others at Friendship Baptist Church.
